What To Bring

The temperature varies during the day, so you will need a variety of clothes, including plenty of warm clothing (long pants) to keep you comfortable during cold evenings. A warm jacket and two pairs of shoes that are suitable for hiking and sports, and a raincoat or umbrella are also recommended. Laundry facilities are not available. A laundry bag would be useful. Most sessions have a “banquet” night, so bring a set of “dressy” clothes.

A warm sleeping bag or several blankets and a pillow (it gets cold at night.)

Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, etc), towels and washcloth, bible, notebook, pen or pencil, flashlight and batteries.

Please identify your belongings with your name.

Please do not bring expensive electronic equipment or food to camp. Snacks and treats (cokes, candy, and non-sweet items) are available in the camp canteen. Cell phones will not work at camp.

Arrival and Departure

Check-in for Pine Springs will be from 2-5 p.m. (NM time) on Sunday. **Please do not arrive before 2 p.m.** Camp ends at **10 a.m.** (NM time) on Friday or Saturday, depending on which day your session ends.

Payment of Account

Each camper’s balance is due **two weeks** prior to their camp session. Please contact the camp office if you have an outstanding balance. **Deposits are nonrefundable and can not be transferred.** If a camper does not attend camp and has not notified the camp office 48 hours prior to the first day of camp, the entire tuition, including the deposit, will be forfeited.

Transportation to Camp

Pine Springs does not provide transportation. You will need to contact the director of the week you are attending.

Medications

Any prescribed medication to be taken at camp should be prepared in the following manner: **1)** placed in a plastic bag with specific instructions, **2)** clearly labeled with camper’s name, and **3)** turned in to camp nurse at registration.

Pine Springs Guidelines

1. For continuity and safety, **campers are not allowed to leave Pine Springs property without the approval of the Camp Director.** If you bring a vehicle, it must remain parked at camp and your keys must be given to the Camp Director. Hiking will be in groups and under the direction of a staff member.
2. Any illness or accident should be reported to your counselor or camp nurse as soon as possible. ALL medicines (prescriptions and OTC medicines) must be turned into the nurse when you register at camp. Do not pack them in your suitcase. The nurse will see that all instructions are followed.
3. Tobacco, alcohol, drugs and weapons are not permitted on the Pine Springs property. Inappropriate language or behavior unbecoming to a Christian will not be tolerated.
4. **We reserve the right to confiscate anything we feel necessary and retain it at our discretion.**
5. Shorts may be worn at Pine Springs, but long pants should be worn to dinner and in the evenings. Any clothing, accessories or symbols that imply gang affiliation are not acceptable and will not be allowed. No spaghetti strap or midriff shirts will be allowed. Clothing with inappropriate advertising, pictures, and/or sayings that are contrary to the mission and Christian standards of LCU is prohibited.
6. Camp personnel reserve the right to remove anyone from campus for disorderly conduct, lack of cooperation or violation of guidelines. No
